Chili Cookoff Team Contestant Rules:

- 1) <u>Chili</u>—Contestants will need to make enough chili to have at least 30 people <u>taste test</u> for judging purposes.
- 2) <u>Set Up</u>—Contestants will be provided a grill and charcoal for keeping the Chili warm. Bowls, Plates, Utensils, Drinks, etc. will be provided. Contestants will need to arrive by at least 11am to set up and be prepared for a 12noon start time.

3) Judging—Judging will be from 12noon until 1pm. There will be 2 types of judging. A) Event Judging for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners. 1st place will receive half of all entry fees collected (\$275 was awarded to the 2009 winner) and the teams name on the Chili Cookoff Trophy, 2nd and 3rd places will also be awarded recognition. The Event Judging will be done by a panel of up to 8 judges who will be selected before the event by the Chili Cookoff Committee. B) Peoples Choice Judging—for the attendee's overall favorite contestant. Every paid attendee will be asked to vote for their favorite contestant. The overall peoples choice award winner will receive recognition at the awards ceremony and an award.

4) <u>Awards</u>—The presentation of awards to winners will take place before the meeting.

5) <u>Contestants Fee</u>—The \$50.00 entry fee pays for the contestants entry and covers the \$10.00 tasting fee for ONE PERSON. If you have more than one person on your team, each additional person will be required to purchase a \$10.00 ticket in order to eat and/or judge for the people choice award.

6) <u>Lastly</u>—After the 1pm judging deadline for submitting votes, all attendee's will be welcome to eat however much of whatever is left of contestants chili & entrée's
